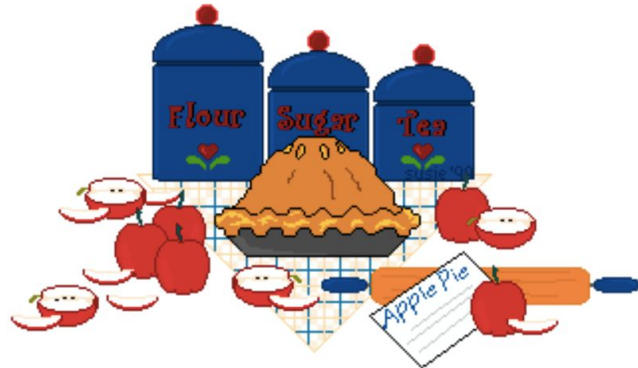


Cookin' Up a Conflict in the Civil War



This review activity centers around the Civil War and identifying the main causes or "ingredients" that led to the conflict. The objective is to turn the events of the Civil War into ingredients for a recipe for the Civil War. Your "ingredients" should be events that specifically led to conflict between the Northern and Southern States. Be specific in your "ingredient" descriptions so we understand **how** they contribute to the whole "dish" of the Civil War. Identify a **minimum of 6** "ingredients" and instructions that describe how they brought the conflict about in the recipe.

You should **include illustrations of the "ingredients" on your final product on WHITE COMPUTER PAPER.** The instructions, illustrations, and recipe as a whole should be neat and colorful.
