## **EXPOSITION**

Setting: English colonies in North America

Antagonist: King George III / Parliament Loyalists/Tories

Protagonist: English colonists in North America Patriots/Minutemen/Militia

## RESOLUTION

Conflict:

**Colonists wanted** 

representation in British Parliament to have

a say in tax policies;

eventually led to declaring

independence from Britain

Treaty of Paris, 1783

- ends the American Revolutionary War
- formally recognized American independence
- granted generous boundaries (west to the Mississippi River, north to the Great Lakes, and south to Spanish Florida)

**EVENT:** The French and Indian War (The Seven Years War) Ends in 1763 with the Treaty of Paris
